We will be operating a 2-week timetable whilst we address the risks of Covid-19 for staff and students within the Academy.

The first full week back will begin on the **7th September** and will be **WEEK 1** for timetable purposes.

Obviously, you will want to know how the Academy will operate on our return in September, so we have provided some key features of our planning within the Academy overleaf. We have been busy preparing for September and will keep you up to date should the advice and guidance change about how we need to operate.

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The next major announcement for education is due on the 11th August 2020.

The Academy will be operating within the DFE and Government system of controls. This will see the following major elements:

- **Year group bubbles**
- **Staggered entry and exit** from the Academy both morning and afternoon
- **Designated toilets** for each year group
- **No cross-year** group activities
- **Split breaks and lunches**
- Vigilance around **hand washing** and **'catch it, bin it, kill it!'**
- **Clean as you go** practices will be in place in all areas of the Academy
- Students will **NOT** be able to use their **lockers**
- Students **must not arrive significantly early** to school and **must leave** once their final teacher supported session is over
- We will be delivering our **full curriculum at both KS3 and KS4** students including specialist subjects
- **This includes PE**, and the associated need to change into and out of **PE kit** for lessons
- **Students will all receive training and induction on our Risk Assessment**, and we need your support to ensure they adhere to this to keep everyone safe
- We will operate a **'Keep left, keep moving, keep apart where possible'** system when moving around the Academy
- Students will receive **'Live Learning' inductions on their first day back** in case we need to respond rapidly to a national or local lockdown
- Students should be in **full school uniform, including ties and blazers**
- **Branded uniform** items can be ordered through the **NK Sports Website** only at this stage. <https://www.nkgrouppuk.com/collections/hans-price-academy>
- Students must **NOT** arrive in September with **coloured hair, facial piercings or acrylic/gel nails**.
- **Make-up**, if worn, **should be discrete**
- **Independent study** for the summer is now available on the **SIMS app** for all year groups
- **Attendance is once again, compulsory for all students** - The government has made it clear they expect us to work alongside families to ensure good attendance and use fines where families are not ensuring regular attendance at school.

We look forward to seeing all our students back in September, in full school uniform, Ready to Learn and ready to make a positive contribution to both our school and our wider community.
